After an assessment has occurred, an appointment needs to be made with the Chief Executive Officer at the Hostel to determine a persons financial situation, the relevant fees and charges, and the options a person has with paying the required fees.

The fees include a daily Board & Lodging fee which is set by the Department of Social Services, and is paid by everyone who receives care.

A Maximum Refundable Accommodation Deposit of \$400,0000.00 could be charged for a "Mt View Homes" room. This is payable as a Daily Accommodation Payment, a lump sum or a combination of both.

Additional services are available at individual costs, and these are available on our website.

Under the Aged Care Act, "Mt View" Homes is obligated to accept a percentage of residents who meet the criteria where no charge is made upon entry into the Homes.
